Harlies Membership Terms and Conditions 2012 v1.0

All members are required to complete the on-line registration form and pay the relevant fee. This process will be referred to hereafter as the “registration process”. All members may register at the link below:

It is a breach of club policy if a player goes onto to a field to participate in a club fixture without first having completed the registration process. It is also a breach of club policy if a coach or manager allows a player onto the field without the player having completed the registration process.

To be eligible for the “Early Bird Fee”, your fees must be paid **in full before 15th May 2012**. **All fees must be paid at time of registration**. On-line credit card payment (via sportinpulse.com), or direct bank transfer (via your personal internet banking) is the preferred method of payment. We will however also accept cash or cheques. Please DO NOT walk into a branch and deposit money into our account via a teller, as BankWest do not provide any information on our statement as to who made the deposit. If you are not in a position to pay all your fees in full by the 15th May, we will accept a monthly direct debit scheme. 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All fees include a levy for player insurance. Player insurance is provided directly via HockeyWA, and the insurance policy can be downloaded from their website (www.hockeywa.org.au). This Player Injury Insurance Policy is placed with Sportscover Australia under the Hockey WA Group Plan.

If no fees have been paid by the first fixture date you will be deemed “un-financial” and will not be covered by player insurance. If you are having trouble paying your fees please contact the Registrar (Brett Kelly) on 0419 949 976 or registrar@harlies.org.au in respect to arranging a payment plan.

The clubrooms at Breckler Park are a smoke free zone (as advised by the City of Stirling). All members are asked to respect this rule while in the clubrooms.

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General Player Commitments and Information

- In order to keep down the cost of playing fees and to pay for equipment, the Club runs a variety of fundraising activities. As a Club member you will be expected to participate in as many activities as possible.
- Our committee works hard to organize Club functions. As a Club Member you will be expected to support the Club by attending as many functions as possible throughout the year.
- The newsletter, containing important information, articles and photos, is published regularly throughout the season. This can be e-mailed to you if you wish. (Please ensure your contact details are correct)
- As a Club Member you will be expected to conduct yourself at all times in a fair and sportsman like manner, bringing credit to our Club. Failure to do so can result in you facing the Harlies tribunal and your membership being withdrawn.
- Throughout the season, senior players may be allocated umpiring fixtures by HockeyWA. Your allocations will appear directly on the HockeyNet system (www.sportingpulse.com). If your team has a bye, it is the personal responsibility of all players to check HockeyNet for your allocations. Failure to meet this commitment means you will be liable to pay the fine incurred from HockeyWA (\$120).
- The club will not be responsible for paying any fines incurred by teams or players. For a full list of fines, please visit www.hockeywa.org.a and download the association and playing rules.

Junior Hockey Player Code of Conduct

At hockey training, games and social events I will:

- Learn and play by the rules of hockey
- Always act responsibly and avoid injury to myself and others
- NEVER argue with an umpire
- Be a good sport and not lose my temper or show physical aggression
- Respect my coach, organisers, the time and effort they give
- Applaud all good plays whether they are made by my team or the opposition.
- Be an active team player and always encourage all other members of my team
- Accept the fact that at certain times I must be a substitute
- Respect all playing equipment and wear our complete uniform with pride
- Regularly attend training on time and be punctual at games
- Try to watch higher grades to learn more



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Parent Code of Conduct

As a parent of a hockey player:

- I will assure that my child follows all the codes outlined above
- I will NEVER argue with an umpire
- I will be a good sport, not lose my temper or show physical aggression
- I will not interfere or talk with coaches while the game is in progress – unless specifically requested to do so
- I will pay all fees by the due date
- I will participate in fundraising activities

Player misconduct such as abuse of umpires, other players or spectators; that bring the club into disrepute will be treated seriously by the Harlies tribunal, which has the right to terminate your membership.

By joining this club as a member, or stepping on to a field to play for the club, it is assumed that you agree to these terms and conditions, and agree to abide by the clubs Constitution, Code of Conduct and the rules/guidelines of the club.

You acknowledge that there are risks involved in playing hockey and agree to indemnify The Harlequin Wanneroo Hockey Club, the WA Hockey Association inc., and all volunteers and employees, and save them harmless and free from liability for any injury or loss suffered by you or your child/children arising out of any activity involving my child and the Club and/or the Western Australian Hockey Association (Inc)

You also acknowledge that you or your child is physically and mentally capable to undertake hockey. If your child has a medical condition please attach a medical certificate, or provide details in the registration form.

You also acknowledge that whilst it is a mandatory requirement for all member clubs of the Western Australian Hockey Association (Inc) participating in Hockey WA competition or events to carry Public Liability Insurance cover, including member to member cover for individual players whilst playing hockey, that it is optional at the club level as to whether a Player Injury Insurance cover is taken out for the Club's individual players and officials.
